Things to Bring to Camp:

Please ensure that on your first day of camp that you have turned in the following: Emergency Form, Field Trip Forms for Walking and Driving Field trips, Parental Agreement, and Waiver of Liability.

Please remember to label EVERYTHING!

SUMMER BRIDGE CAMP STUDENTS:

- Comfortable clothes that can get dirty and are weather appropriate
- Bag or backpack to carry items
- Sunscreen (Make sure that your child comes to camp with sunscreen already on)
- Two healthy snacks (am and pm) and a lunch
- Closed toe shoes
- Swimsuit and towel
- Always keep a bag of extra clothes in your child's backpack just in case.
- Two sets of masks

FRIDAY FUNDAYS:

- Tech items that cannot get on the internet are allowed (no cell phones with internet are allowed). Wifi will not be used during tech time. Games must be appropriate for all ages. All tech items are brought at the student's risk and The Principled Academy is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Tech toys will also be available through the camp for those who do not have any.

Toys from home, including trading cards, cell phones, and electronic gaming devices are not permitted at camp (exception on Fridays for electronics)

JR. REC LEADERS

- Closed toe shoes
- Must wear either black, khaki, or blue pants (jeans ok)
- Will be provided a Camp shirt to be worn on Wednesday field trip days
- Tops must be monochrome in either white, black, blue, gray, or green. Sleeveless is ok as long as straps are thick (2 inches). TPA school shirts can be worn as well.
- Shorts can be worn, but please make sure they are at an appropriate length; if too short we will ask that the Jr. Rec Leader go home to change.
- Healthy snacks and a lunch

Camp Activities and Calendar

A typical day in camp will include camp meetings, songs, group games, arts and crafts, team building exercises, field trips, and special events. In the mornings students will participate in summer bridge activities which include Math, English Language Arts, Science, STEAM, coding, and educational games on the computer. Please follow the camp calendar to keep informed of all that is happening in camp that week. Expect to receive a weekly email via Gradelink on the upcoming week's events on Fridays. Of course some activities and field trips are subject to change based on numbers and children's interests.

Sign In/Out Procedure

For the safety of all students, we require that all students are signed in and out by an authorized adult every day. Children cannot be signed out by anyone under the age of 18. For their safety, children may not sign themselves out of the program. We use iPads for signing in and out.

It is imperative that your child be picked up 6:15pm. Late parents will be charged \$15.00. If a child is not picked up by 6:30pm, we reserve the right to contact the San Leandro Police. Parents who pick up later than 6:15 on three separate occasions will be given a written warning regarding program policies.

Camp Shirts

All campers will receive a camp T-Shirt. **Camp shirts must be worn on all field trip days.**

Field Trip/Permission Slips

All campers must have a signed permission slip on hand for any and all field trips that they wish to attend. The program will not provide care for campers who do not wish to attend. Early pick-ups from the field trip must be pre-arranged and may not always be an option. On field trip days, it is imperative that your child arrives to the program by 8:30am or time posted. Return time will be noted on the weekly schedule of events. **Please see the weekly schedule of events for specific information regarding each field trip.**

Medical Record Information

To ensure the safety of all children in our program, we require an emergency form to be completed before the child can participate in the program. It's your responsibility to share with us any information that we may need to know about your child.

Medication

If your child must take medication while at camp, please inform Ms. Dalina on the first day of your session. A medication release form signed by a parent/guardian and the child's doctor is required. The medication must be in its original container with the prescription clearly labeled by the physician. Please do not leave medication with your child. This includes over-the-counter medication.

Illness

If your child is/or becomes ill while at camp, staff will contact parents/guardians to come and pick up the child. The program is not set up to care for sick children, so it is important to tend to your child in a timely manner. Please ensure that you have an additional person to pick up your child in case of an emergency and you cannot be reached. We will follow all COVID-19 guidelines for when your child will be cleared to return to camp.

Injury

If your child is injured, the staff will take the necessary steps to provide or obtain medical care. In the event of serious injury, emergency services will be called first and then parent/guardians. Minor incidents such as scrapes and bruises will be reported to you upon pick up of your child. Any head injuries will be reported to a parent/guardian immediately via phone call.

Snacks and Lunch

All campers must bring two healthy snacks (am and pm), as camp does not provide snacks. Please ensure that any perishable items are packed in a lunch container with an ice pack. Additionally, students will need to bring a lunch M-F. We do have microwaves on site to heat up items.

Water

Each student must bring their own labeled water bottle, especially on hot days and field trip days.

Water play will also happen M, T, Th, and F. We will play water games, in wading pools, sprinklers, and with special event water slides.

Camp Staff

The camp is supervised and led by a TPA main room classroom teacher. Additional paid staff will have background checks, TB tested, and have participated in pre-summer training to enhance their skills in working with children.

Jr. Rec Leaders are not staff members but are campers in training to become camp staff. Rec leaders will not be managing campers or supervising them directly.

Communication

We value communication between parents and staff members and know that better communication will lead to a better camp experience and increased success of the program. On the Friday prior to your camp session, you will receive an email with all pertinent information on the upcoming week. Additionally, camp staff is available to discuss any issues with your child or your camp experience daily.

Behavior Policy

Camp should be an enjoyable experience for all participants and staff. Campers will be expected to follow the camper code of conduct for their safety, as well as the safety of others. The camp staff will model positive behavior and respect, as well as assist your child in learning to make positive choices for him or herself as well. Our staff have been coached on proper behavior guidance techniques including re-direction, conflict resolution, and positive discipline.

Campers who continually disrupt the group or exhibit unacceptable behavior may be removed from activities. In extreme situations, campers may need to leave the camp for the day or be suspended from the program.
