Things to Bring to Camp:

Please ensure that on your first day of camp that you have turned in the following: Emergency Form, Parental Agreement, and Waiver of Liability.

Please remember to label EVERYTHING!

SUMMER BRIDGE CAMP STUDENTS:

- Comfortable clothes that can get dirty and are weather appropriate
- Bag or backpack to carry items
- Sunscreen (Make sure that your child comes to camp with sunscreen already on)
- Two healthy snacks (am and pm) and a lunch
- Closed toe shoes
- Swimsuit and towel
- A bag of extra clothes in your child's backpack just in case.
- Students need to be dressed appropriately, no ripped or torn clothing, or clothing with inappropriate phrase.

Camp Activities

A typical day in summer camp will include learning activities, camp meetings, songs, group games, arts and crafts, team building exercises, and special events. Daily, students will participate in summer bridge activities which include Math, English Language Arts, Science, and STEAM. Expect to receive a weekly email via Gradelink on the upcoming week's events. Of course, some activities are subject to change based on numbers, weather, and children's interests.

Sign In/Out Procedure

For the safety of all students, we require that all students are signed in and out by an authorized adult every day. Children cannot be signed out by anyone under the age of 18. For their safety, children may not sign themselves in or out of the program. We use iPads to check in and out.

It is imperative that your child be picked up by 6:15pm. Late parents will be charged \$15.00. If a child is not picked up by 6:30pm, we reserve the right to contact the San Leandro Police. Parents who pick up later than 6:15 on three separate occasions will be given a written warning regarding program policies.

Medical Record Information

To ensure the safety of all children in our program, we require an emergency form to be completed before the child is allowed to participate in the program. It's your responsibility to share with us any information that we may need to know about your child.

Illness

If your child is/or becomes ill while at camp, staff will contact parents/guardians to come and pick up the child. The program is not set up to care for sick children, so it is important to tend to your child in a timely manner. Please ensure that you have an additional person to pick up your child in case of an emergency and you cannot be reached. Additionally, your child needs to stay home from camp if he/she is ill particularly if he or she has vomited, had loose bowels, or a fever in the last 24 hours.

Injury

If your child is injured, the staff will take the necessary steps to provide or obtain medical care. In the event of serious injury, emergency services will be called first and then parent/guardians. Minor incidents such as scrapes and bruises will be reported to you upon pick up of your child. Any head injuries will be reported to a parent/guardian immediately via phone call.

Snacks and Lunch

All campers must bring two healthy snacks (am and pm), as camp does not provide snacks. Please ensure that any perishable items are packed in a lunch container with an ice pack. Additionally, students will need to bring a lunch M-F.

Water

Each student must bring their own labeled water bottle, especially on hot days.

Water play will also happen M - F. We will have water games and wading pools.

Evaluations

On Fridays, a survey via Google Forms will be sent out to families that attended during the week prior. Please feel free to let us know what is working for you and your child, as well as what we can do to improve our program. We value your feedback.

Camp Staff

The camp is supervised and led by a TPA main classroom teacher. Additional paid staff will have background checks, TB tested, and will have participated in pre-summer training to enhance their skills in working with children.

Jr. Rec Leaders are not staff members but are campers in training to become camp staff. Jr. Rec leaders will not be managing campers or supervising them directly.

Communication

We value communication between parents and staff members and know that better communication will lead to a better camp experience and increased success of the program. On the Friday prior to your camp session, you will receive an email with all pertinent information on the upcoming week. At the end of the week, you will receive an email with an evaluation about the previous session. Additionally, camp staff is available to discuss any issues with your child or your camp experience on a daily basis.

Behavior Policy

Camp should be an enjoyable experience for all participants and staff. Campers will be expected to follow the camper code of conduct for their safety, as well as the safety of others. The camp staff will model positive behavior and respect, and will assist your child in learning to make positive choices for him or herself as well. Our staff have been coached on proper behavior guidance techniques including re-direction, conflict resolution, and positive discipline.

Campers who continually disrupt the group or exhibit unacceptable behavior may be removed from activities. In extreme situations, campers may need to leave the camp for the day or be suspended from the program.
