Enrichment Clubs Payment Plans

Dear TPA Families,

We are committed to provide for our students various enrichment clubs during the school year. We feel these clubs are important and add an additional variation and depth to the school curriculum. We want to serve the families and be as flexible as possible while keeping the record keeping to a minimum, so for paying club dues we are offering four options:

- 1. Prepay for the whole school year at a significant discount rate (no discount for Chess Club).
- 2. Pay per session dues through our autopay program. Each session will be charged automatically at the beginning of the month. If the student does not want to continue with the club you can contact the office and cancel anytime.
- 3. Set up recurring automatic payments for each month through Paypal.
- 4. Bring in payment at least a week in advance for a future specific class or session. The student will be enrolled in that class or session, but will not be not on the roster for other classes or sessions. Reminders will not be sent for new sessions so if you choose this option you will need to keep track. If a student misses a class because they were not on the roster you can enroll for partial sessions, but again, payment must be submitted at least a week in advance.

For all our clubs if your student is enrolled for a class but is out sick or not in the class a credit will be noted on your account and applied to future classes or to other open items on your account, with the exception of the Chess Club or for prepayment for the whole school year since that already has a discount built into the dues.
